



Professor Dr. Marko Cincović was born in Priboj on September 7, 1984. He is a full professor of pathophysiology, clinical hematology, and animal biochemistry at the Department of Veterinary Medicine, Faculty of Agriculture, University of Novi Sad. He received his undergraduate and PhD degrees in veterinary medicine from the University of Novi Sad, his specialist studies at the Faculty of Veterinary Medicine in Belgrade, and his postdoctoral studies at the Veterinary Faculty in Ljubljana. He finished all of his studies, summa cum laude. He received scholarships from the Serbian Ministry of Education and Science and the Slovenian Science Agency. He has published nearly 450 scientific papers, including 70 on the SCI list. Professor Cincović has authored over 20 university textbooks, practical guides, and monographs. He participated in or coordinated 21 national and international initiatives focusing on ruminant clinical pathology, animal heat stress, and veterinary education. He has mentored seven doctorate dissertations and six graduate, master's, and specialist theses, as well as served on over 70 committees for the evaluation and defense of theses. Professor Cincović has been a member of committees for the recruitment of academic staff and researchers in the country and region. For over 50 international and domestic journals, Professor Cincović was a reviewer and has conducted more than 150 reviews. He is a member of the editorial board of several scientific and professional journals. He has organized several national and international conferences and workshops for continuous veterinary education. He has established business and technical cooperation with over 10 companies and small and medium-sized enterprises. He has held numerous positions at the faculty (director of the Department of Veterinary Medicine, 2017-2021) and is currently the head of the Laboratory for Pathophysiology, which is the main clinical laboratory at the Department of Veterinary Medicine in Novi Sad. He has received numerous awards and honors (student of the year, dean's and rector's awards for published student scientific papers, two awards for "monograph of the year" for published books, an award for the highest number of published papers from the SCI list on the faculty's anniversary, several certificates and acknowledgments from professional associations, and several papers in international journals that have been recognized as Hot Topics in their field). Professor Cincović's research interests include animal clinical pathology, laboratory medicine, ruminant metabolism, metabolic adaptability to stresses, and heat tolerance.
